Why Braillo 400 CS2?

The Braillo 400 CS2 is designed to simplify large-scale braille production, reduce finishing steps and create more inclusive publications with outstanding efficiency.

CUT-SHEET FLEXIBILITY



Emboss directly onto individual sheets — no continuous paper, tractor-feed, cutters or bursters required. Simply load individual sheets and produce finished braille documents with less equipment and fewer production steps.

DUAL-FORMAT DOCUMENTS



Add braille to pre-printed pages by combining ink print, graphics and braille on the same sheet. This creates accessible documents for both sighted and braille readers without the need for separate print and braille versions.

HIGH-SPEED PRODUCTION



Produce up to 1,200 pages per hour with an automatic feeder that holds up to 300 sheets, enabling uninterrupted, high-volume production while maintaining consistent braille quality through extended print runs.

MULTIPLE PUBLICATION TYPES



Produce books, magazines, newspapers, document covers and educational material using two-page, four-page or single-sided production formats for greater publishing versatility.

FLEXIBLE PAPER HANDLING



Use readily available cut-sheet paper in a variety of sizes and weights, including pre-printed and pre-punched sheets, reducing reliance on specialised continuous-feed paper.

SEAMLESS WORKFLOW



Integrates easily with existing production and binding processes while reducing finishing equipment and simplifying the overall braille production workflow.
